

Privacy Statement

Commitment to Individual Privacy

Mesa State College is committed to protecting the privacy and accuracy of confidential information submitted by employees, students and visitors to our Web site. However, because Mesa State College is a public institution, some personally identifiable information may be subject to disclosure pursuant to the Colorado Open Records Act (C.R.S. § 24-72-101 *et seq.*).

Colorado Open Records Act (C.R.S. § 24-72-101 *et seq.*)

The State of Colorado requires that all public records be open for public inspection by any person except as otherwise provided by law. Public Records are defined as all writings made or maintained by a state institution, such as Mesa State College, regardless of medium or format. Personal information provided to the College may be subject to public inspection and copying unless protected by state or federal law.

Family Education Rights and Privacy Act (20 U.S.C. § 1232g)

Mesa State College also complies with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), which generally prohibits the release of students' education records without consent. However, Mesa State College may release student directory information or student educational records if allowed or required by FERPA. For more information about FERPA, contact the Registrar's Office

Information Collected

It is Mesa State College's practice to collect the least amount of personally identifiable information necessary to fulfill its required duties and responsibilities, complete a particular transaction, deliver services, or as required by law. This applies to all personally identifiable information regardless of medium or source.

For site administration functions, information, other than personal information linked to particular individual, is collected for analysis and statistical purposes. Such information may include user visit logs, network traffic logs and small text files known as "cookies". This information is used to help diagnose problems, analyze site usage, access system performance, better plan our website to meet users needs, and for marketing purposes. Information collected and information you provide to us may result in follow-up communications.

Individuals may choose whether or not to provide personal information to Mesa State College via the Internet. If you choose not to provide the personal information we request, you can still visit most of Mesa State College's web pages, but you may be unable to access certain options, offers, and services that involve our interaction with you. You can opt out of the use of cookies by having your browser disable cookies or warn you before accepting a cookie.

Some Mesa State College website pages allow users to request information from the College. These information request sites require users to provide contact information as well as information about their interest in Mesa State College. Contact information is used to send information about Mesa State College to the customer requesting that information. Customer interest information is collected to determine what information the customer wishes to be sent. You can choose NOT to provide this information online and instead call Mesa State College to request that information be sent to you.

Some of our sites also allow users to provide feedback to Mesa State College. Our survey sites, such as feedback forms on the website and MAVzone, the student and faculty portal, request users to provide contact information as well. The contact information that's collected is used to contact the website user, if necessary. Opt-out policy: You can choose NOT to disclose contact information when you submit survey information to us. However, if your comments require follow-up by a member of the College, we will be unable to do so when contact information is not available.

Third Party Services

On Mesa State College's behalf, third parties may provide certain services available on Mesa State's web site. Mesa State College may provide information, including personal information, collected over the Internet to third party providers to help us deliver programs, products, information, and services. We will take reasonable steps to ensure that these third party service providers are obligated to protect personal information on our behalf.
